As we begin the hurricane season, June 1st through November 30th, attached is a link for a hurricane preparedness guide. Beaufort County is very diligent about their evacuation procedures. Whereas the County previously would issue a 5-day voluntary evacuation, evacuations are now mandatory. If a hurricane evacuation is ordered, American Red Cross shelters are open to all and information is available at www.redcross.org/pepare/mobile-apps. Beaufort County residents will be required to take predetermined routes depending on where they live.

Beaufort County residents should call the emergency management agency to find out when it will be safe to return (1-800-963-5023). Residents must have a form of identification and proof of residency or lease upon returning because there will be roadblocks manned by SC Highway Patrol. Register yourself as “safe and well” at www.redcross.org/safeandwell or by calling 1-866-GET-INFO. Concerned family and friends can search for their loved one’s name, an “as of” date and any corresponding messages.
